Tips & Safety

Printing with Magnetic Powder

- Stop dusting as soon as you see a latent print to avoid removing too much of the magnetic powder.
 - If a very greasy print shows up as a solid blob, additional sweeps with the wand may help.
- For best results, always use the magnetic applicator wand with the magnet end down.
- To create fingerprints, rub the side of your nose, forehead or hair, and then touch the surface where you want to leave the print.

Work Station Best Practices

- Use on a surface that can be cleaned with water or discarded.
- · Use outdoors if possible.
- Cover your work area with an empty plastic trash bag, and discard everything after use.
- Do not use near food or food preparation areas.
- · When finished, clean with copious water.
- Use protective gear: gloves, breathing mask.
- Store your forensic supplies in a cool, dry place.
