

FOOTPRINT CASTING PACKING LIST

- One 5-pound container of casting compound
- Two 2-pound bags of Traxtone casting powder
- One plastic casting container
- One 5-pack of 2" x 2" evidence labels
- One 2-ounce bottle of dirt hardener AKA hairspray

Tips & Safety

- Make sure all of your supplies are handy before you start.
- Dry, loosely-packed soil works best for creating shoeprints and tire tracks for casting.
- When photographing shoeprint or tire impressions, include a ruler or tape measure in the photo for scale.

Traxtone Casting Powder

- Traxtone powder is very fine, so masks are recommended when using this item.
- Traxtone powder can also be flammable, so use it outside and away from open flames.
- To make more casts with your Traxtone, you can divide each 2-pound bag into two 1-pound bags. Simply pour half of a bag's contents into a gallon-size zip-seal plastic bag.
 - » Because Traxtone powder is very fine, this could get messy. Divide the bags outdoors if at all possible.
- The casting frame is used with Traxtone casting to protect the integrity of the impression while providing a "wall" to contain the mixture.

Casting Compound

- The casting compound is a unique molding material which is non-toxic and eco-friendly.
- It will not stick to clothes, hands, or other surfaces.
- It can be used over and over because it never dries out.
