## **Tips & Safety**

- The body bag included in your ForensiKit is the same kind professionals use in the field. It is designed to be liquid and air-tight.
  - » DO NOT close up any person inside the body bag.
  - » The body bag is a suffocation hazard.
  - » The body bag cannot be opened from the inside.
- After the water-soluble trace evidence tape has dissolved, you can use one pair of tweezers to carefully remove some of the pulpy material from the water before pouring the mixture through the filter.
- You can make additional trace evidence folds called a bindle— using folded paper.

## **IMPORTANT**



NEVER zip the body bag fully closed with a living person inside.

They will suffocate.
